RESOLUTION FOR A NEW CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN ADJUNCT TEACHING

Rationale: The University Faculty Senate recognizes the importance of excellence of instruction by all faculty. Currently, adjunct faculty are not eligible for the award for Excellence in Teaching. The SUNY Chancellor has expressed her support for a new Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching. In response to a request from the UFS president, the University Faculty Senate Programs and Awards Committee has drafted a proposal for a Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching.

Resolution: Whereas the University Faculty Senate and SUNY Chancellor have identified adjunct teaching as critical to the success of our students across SUNY institutions, and

Whereas the University Faculty Senate would like to recognize excellence in adjunct teaching, and

Whereas the conferral of the Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching would publicly proclaim SUNY's pride in the accomplishments and personal dedication of its adjunct instructional faculty, and

Whereas Adjunct Faculty are now excluded from receiving the Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching,

Therefore, be it resolved that the University Faculty Senate endorses the creation of a Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching.

And, be it further resolved that University Faculty Senate endorses the new Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching as submitted by the SUNY Program and Awards Committee.
