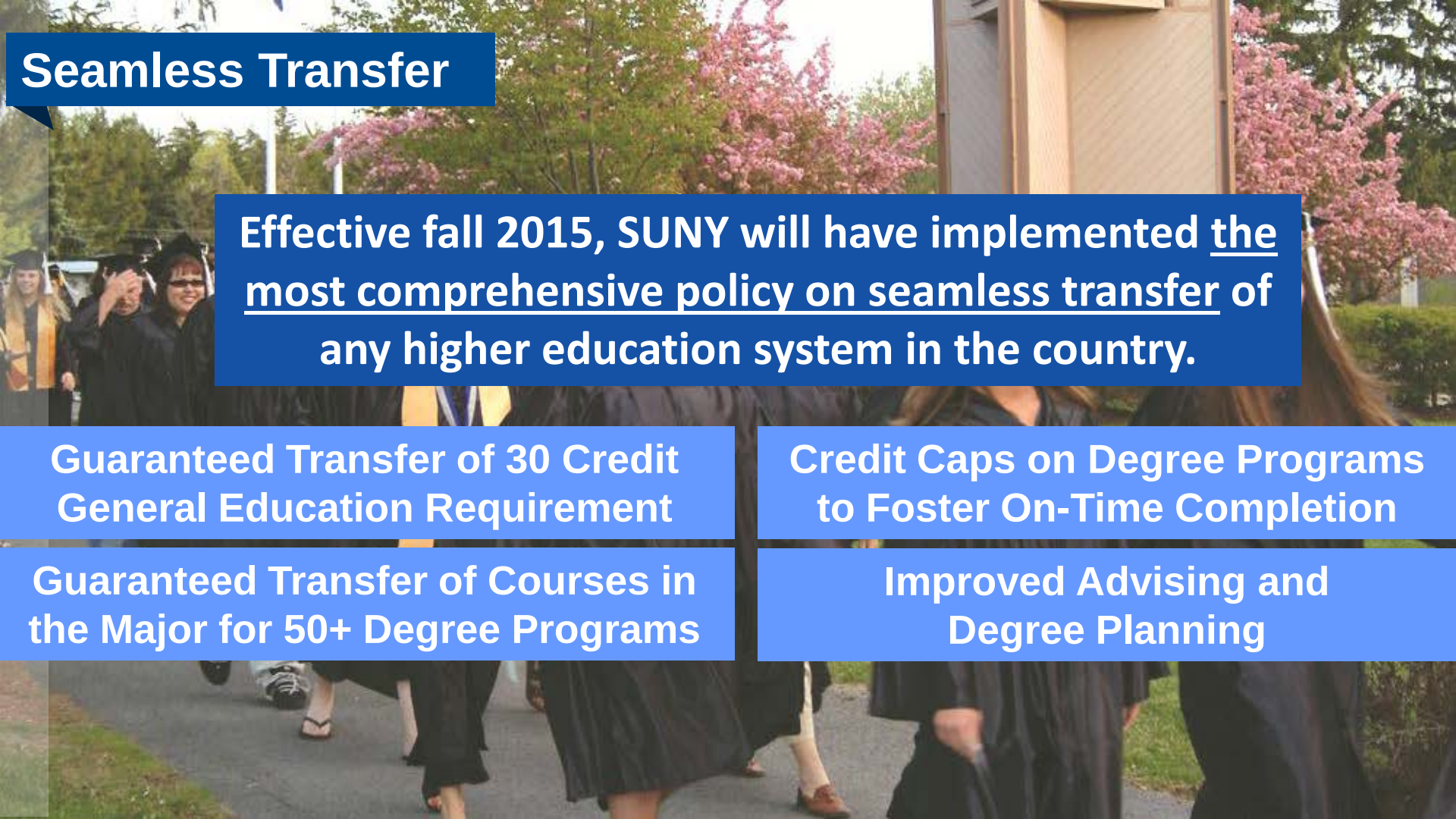

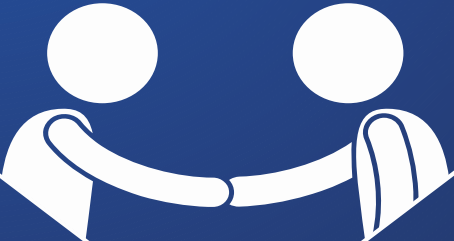

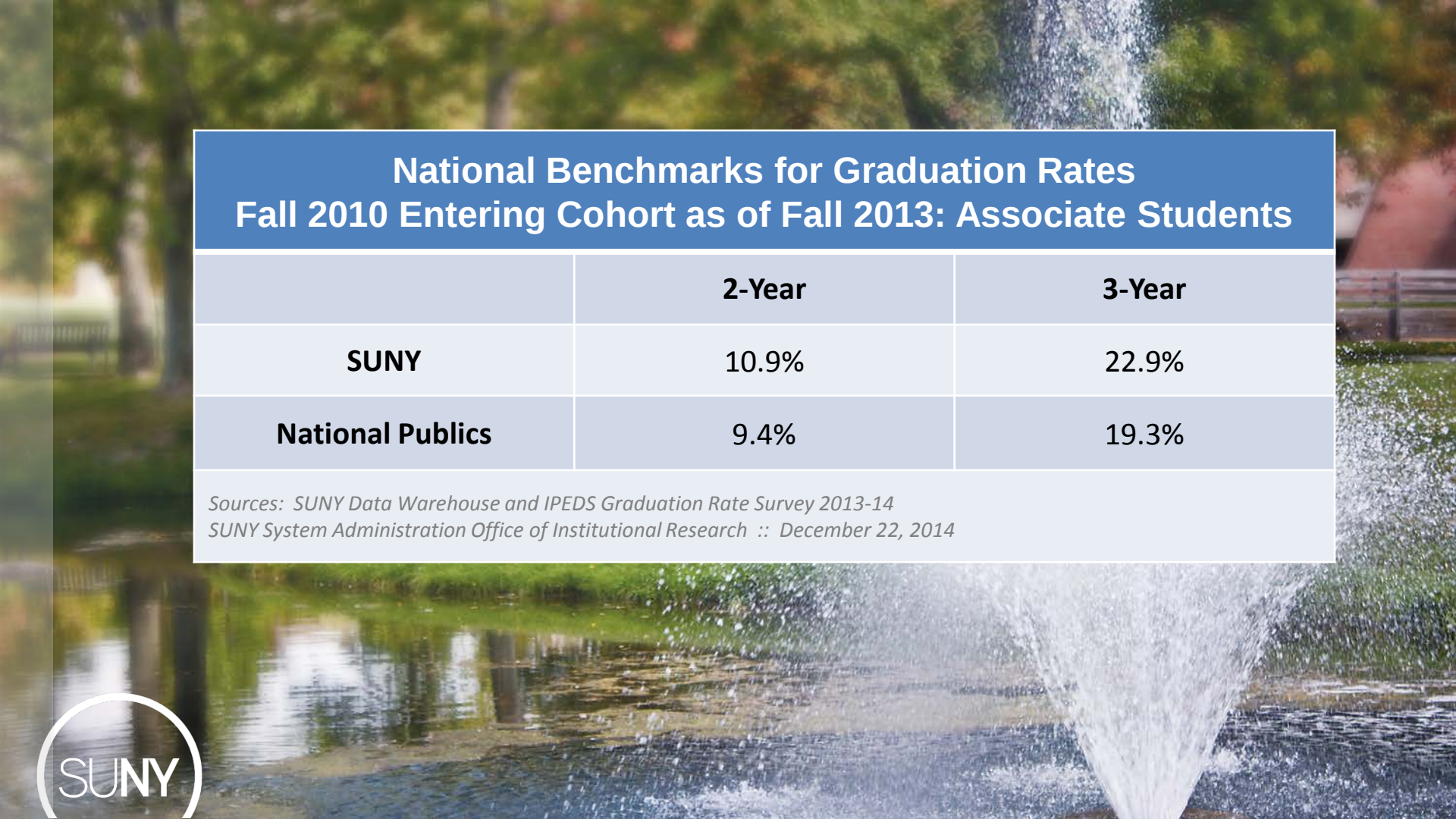

National Benchmarks for Graduation Rates Fall 2010 Entering Cohort as of Fall 2013: Associate Students

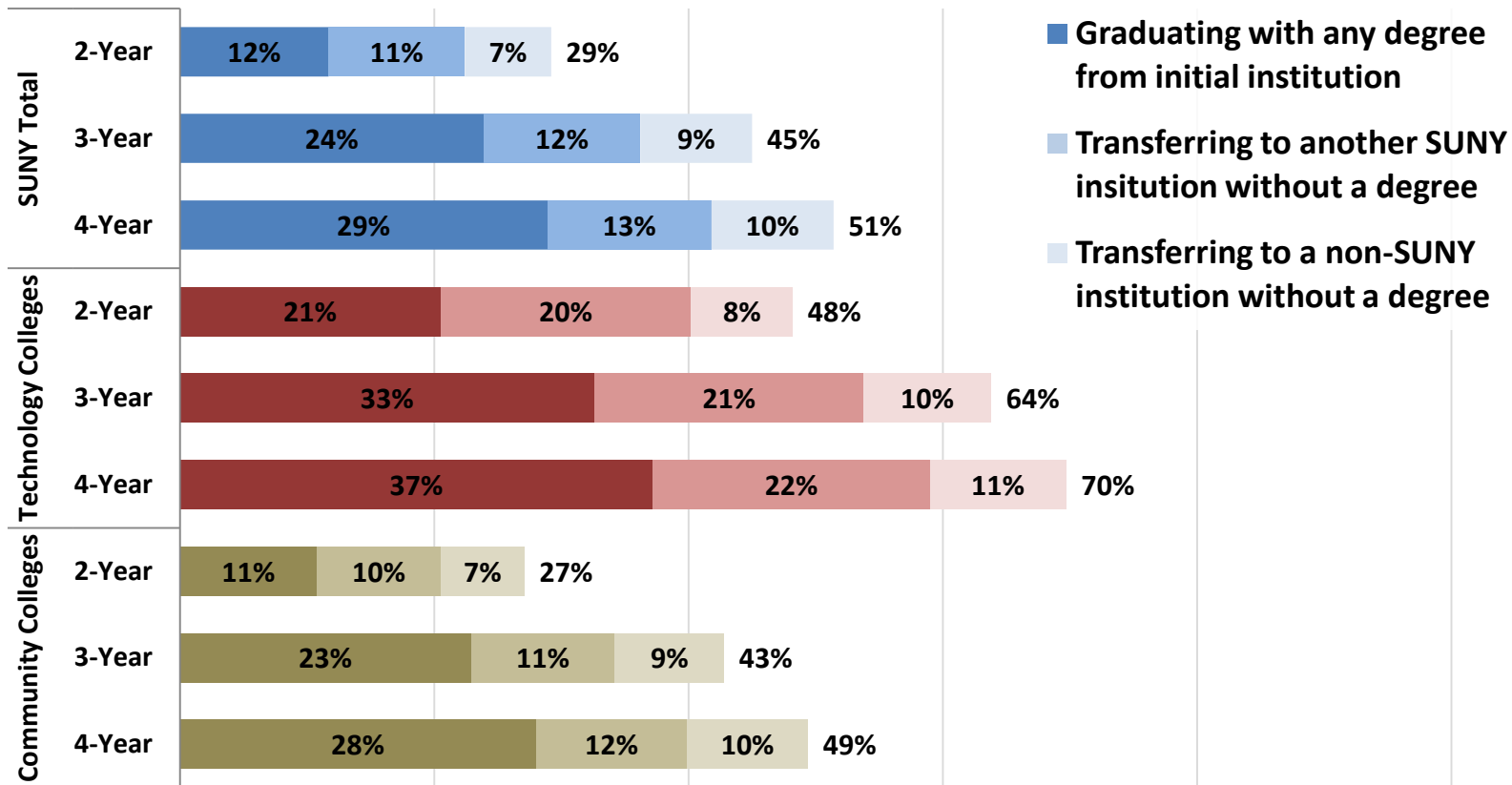

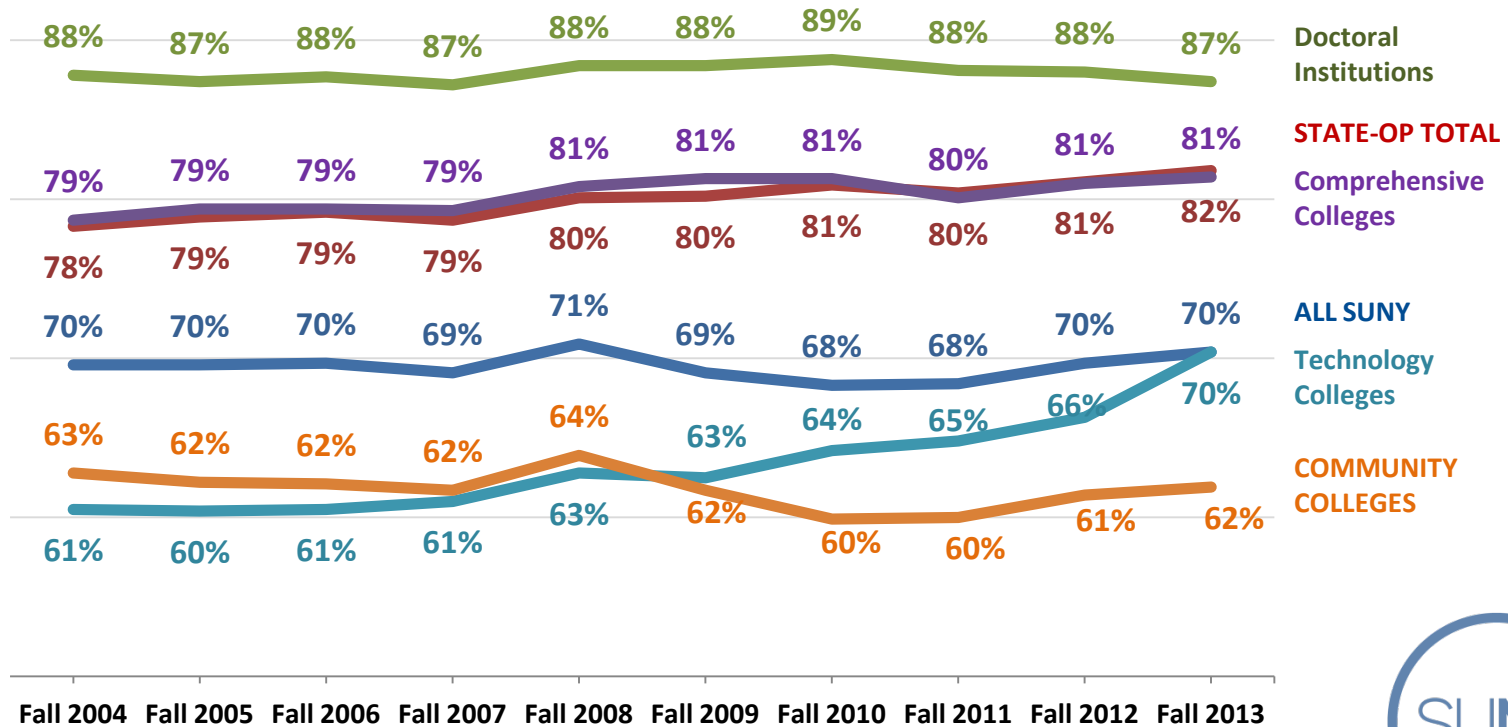
Graduation and Transfer-Out

First-Time, Full-Time Associate Students, Entering Cohort 2009

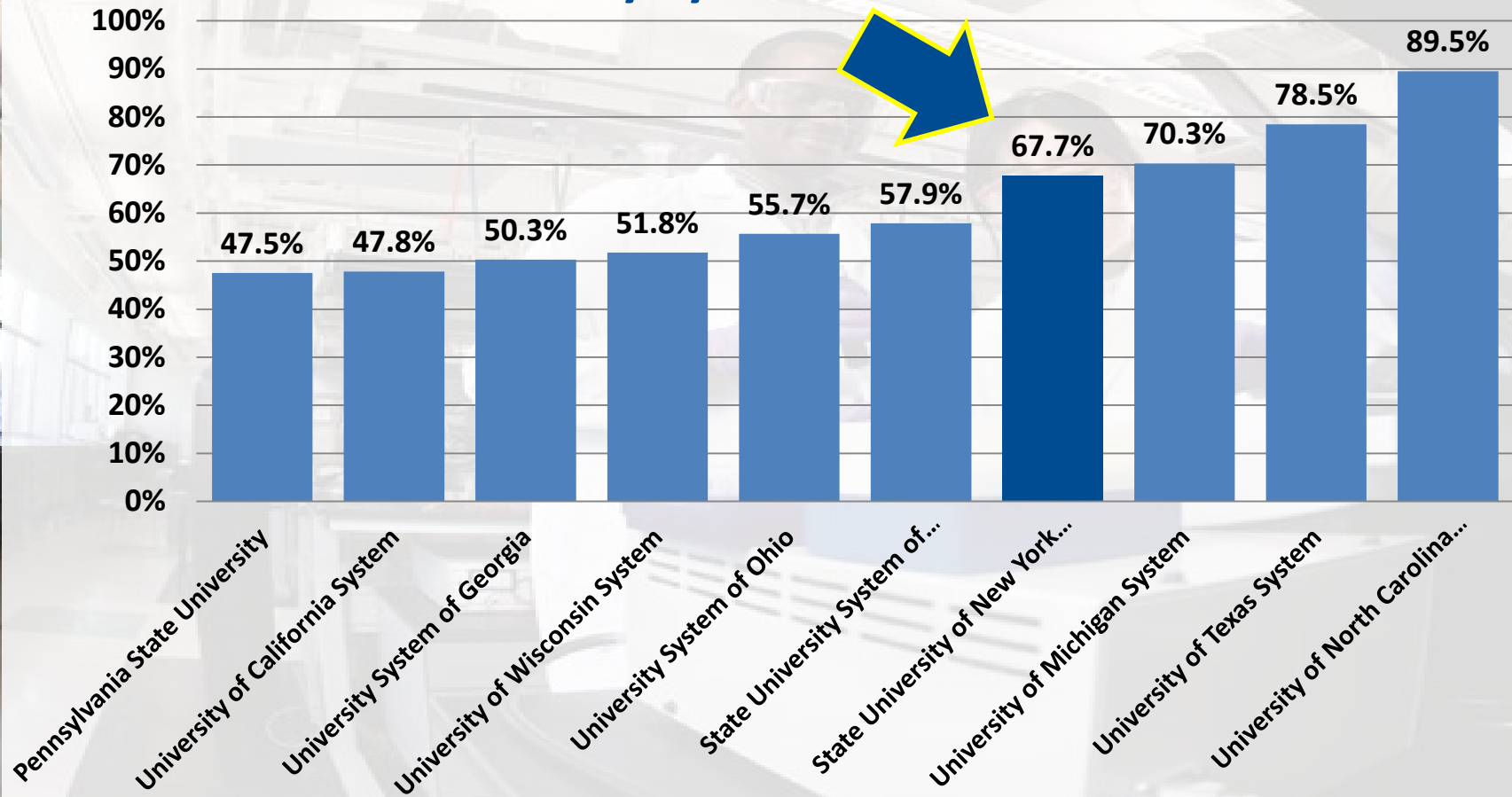


First-Year Retention

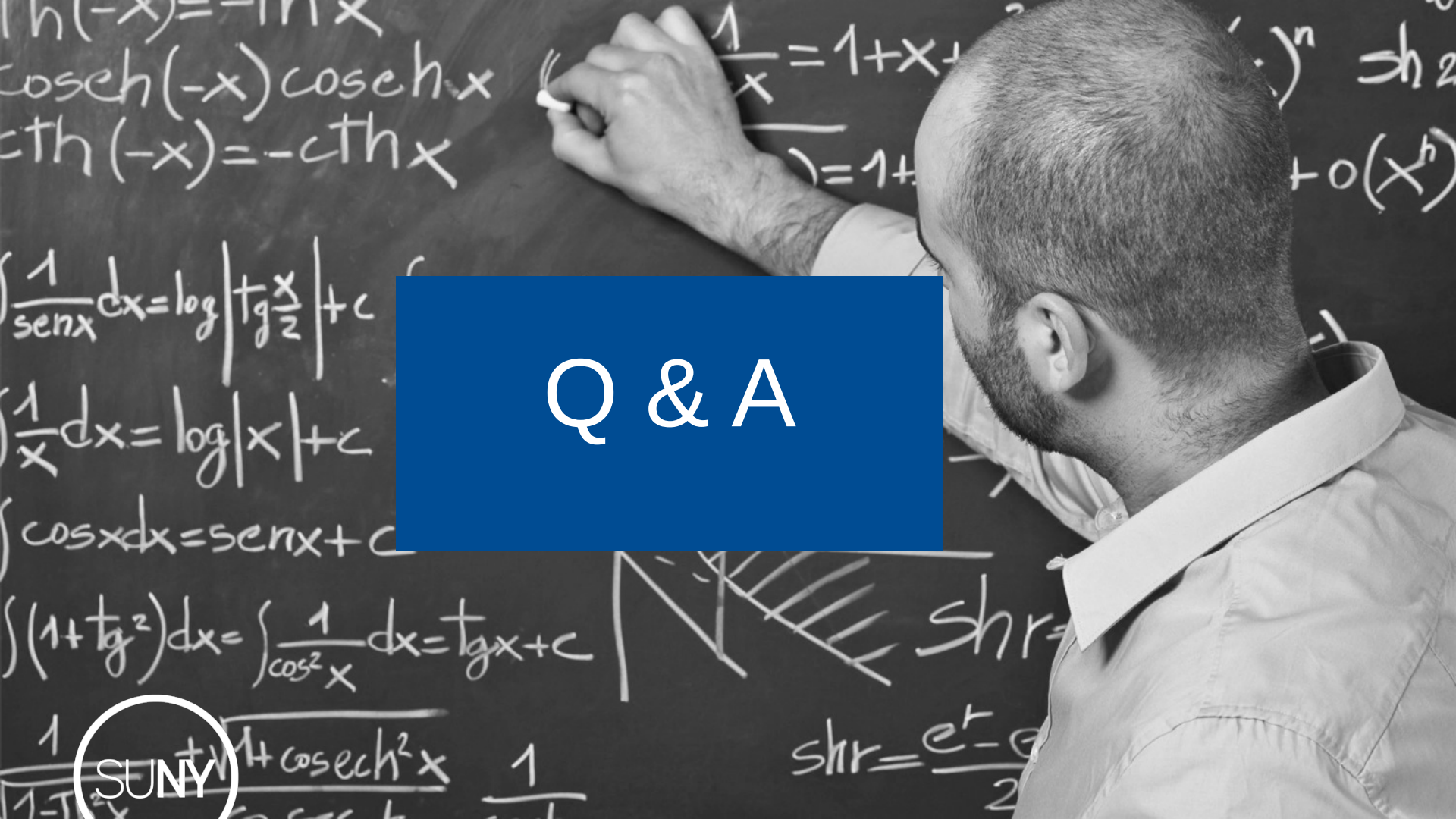

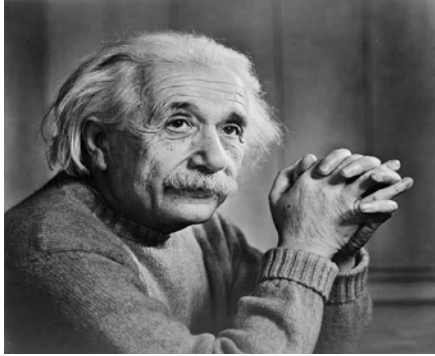
