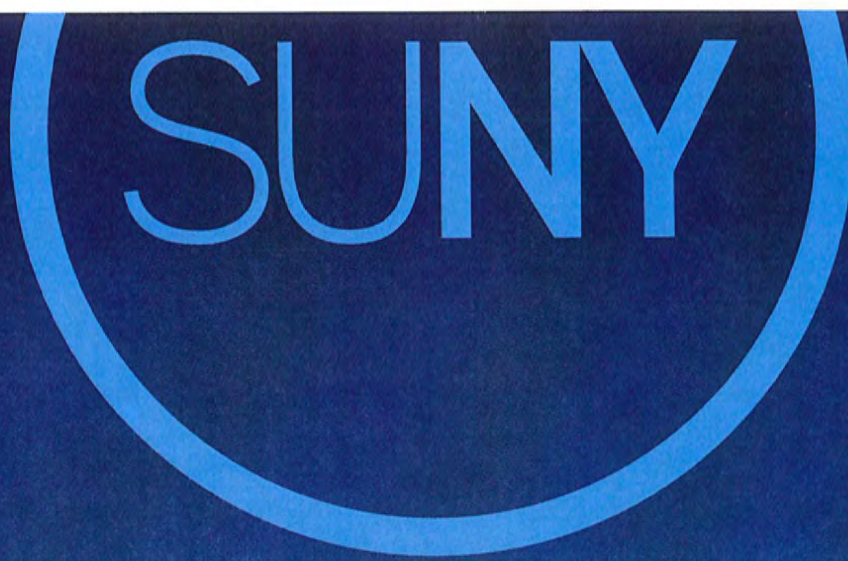

INTRODUCTION

The State University of New York has compiled the Fundraising Survey Report using *Voluntary Support of Education Reporting Standards* for reporting annual fundraising results. Information contained in this report may be used as an effective mechanism to monitor progress in achieving SUNY campaign and individual campus goals, to facilitate comparisons among peers within and outside the State University, and to share fundraising “best practices”. To ensure these comparisons are meaningful and accurate, the State-operated campuses and community colleges are asked to follow the applicable reporting standards when completing the Council for Aid of Education VSE survey form used to compile the information in this report.

A brief overview and description of the contents of the *Fundraising Survey Report* for the 2014-15 fiscal year follows:

Executive Summary (pages 3-6) – Presents a summary of University-wide fundraising information with comparisons to the previous year and five-year trend information for all colleges and universities.

Summary of Gifts Received (pages 7-9) – Reflects the compiled results of the survey completed by the colleges and universities with a comparison to the previous year’s totals. The schedule provides detail of the types of restrictions placed on gifts, the total outright gifts and deferred gifts.

Summary of Gifts by Type (pages 10-11) – Displays the total gifts by colleges and universities (in descending dollar order) by type of gift. The classification types are:

- Unrestricted - gifts given without any restriction.
- Restricted for property, plant and equipment (PP&E) - gifts of real and personal property or gifts that the donor has restricted to use for purchasing, constructing, renovating, or retiring debt of buildings, equipment, land or facilities.
- Restricted other - gifts that the donor has restricted to use for a particular purpose (i.e., scholarships, research, institutional support, athletics, etc.)
- Endowment - gifts that donors specify are to be retained and invested for income-producing purposes. The income on these gifts can be unrestricted or restricted.

Summary of Gifts by Source (pages 12-13) – Displays the total gifts by colleges and universities by the source of gift (i.e., individuals or corporations/foundations).

Comparison of Gifts by Campus to the Previous Year (pages 14-19) – Reflects a comparison (increase or decrease and percentage change) of gifts received by campus in the current year versus the previous year in total, from individuals, and from corporations/foundations.

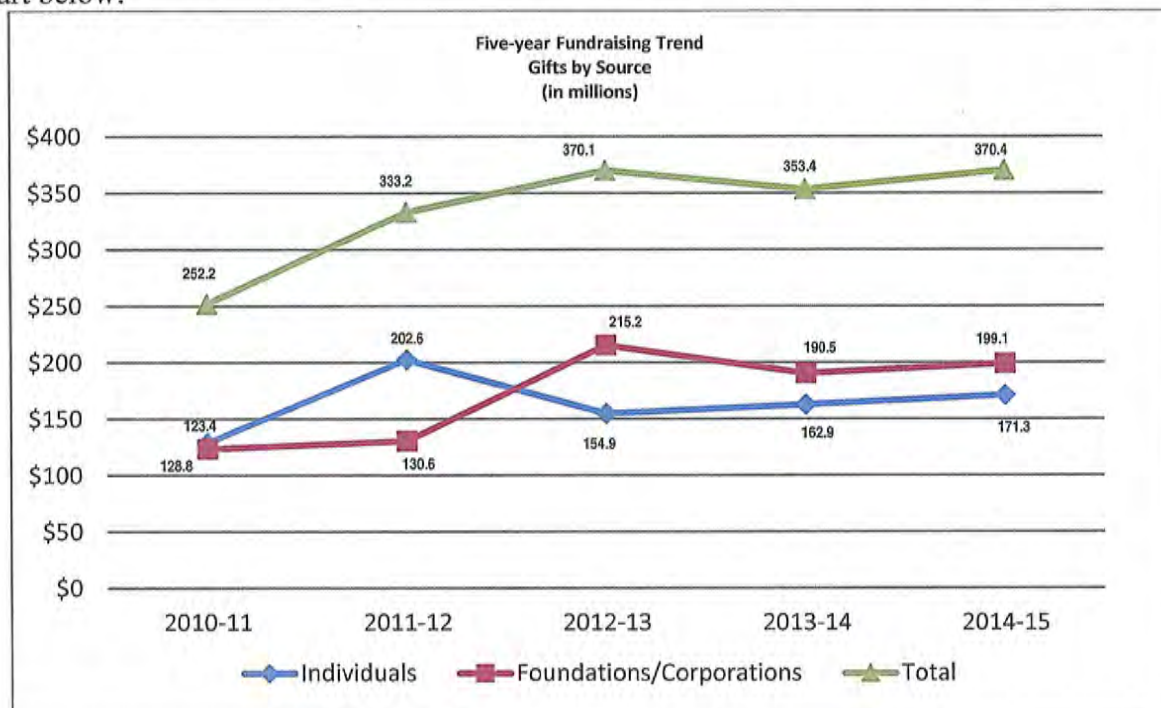
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The amounts reported in this survey include cash, property and gifts-in-kind received as private, charitable support during the fiscal year. Based on the survey completed by the colleges and universities for the 2014-15 fiscal year, total gifts received were \$370.4 million, an increase of \$17 million compared to the previous year. This result is driven by a \$20.7 million increase reported by the State-operated campuses offset by a decrease of \$3.7 million reported by the community colleges.

Gifts received from individuals (including alumni, parents, and others) constitute 46.2 percent of all gift giving, while corporation and foundation giving represent 53.8 percent of the total. Overall, gifts received from individuals in 2014-15 totaled \$171.3 million, an increase of \$8.4 million compared to 2013-14. Corporations and foundation gift giving increased from \$190.5 million in 2013-14 to \$199.1 million in 2014-15.

Corporate and foundation gifts received in 2014-15 increased \$8.6 million from the prior year and is higher by \$27.4 million compared to the five-year average. Gifts from individuals received in 2014-15 were \$8.4 million, or 5.2 percent, higher compared to the previous year, and \$7.2 million higher than the average giving over the last five years. The five-year fundraising trend for the State University by individuals and corporations and foundations is reflected in the chart below:

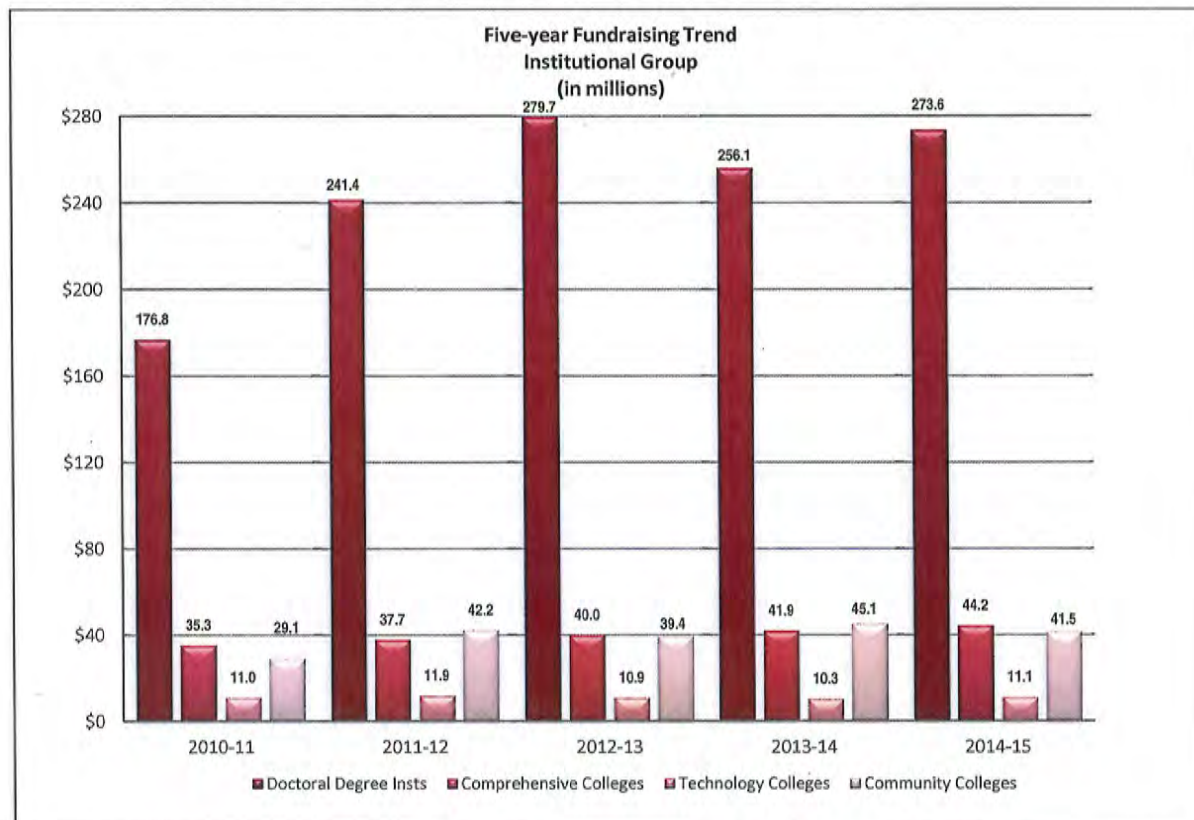

Doctoral degree granting institutions gifts increased \$17.5 million, or 6.9 percent, comprehensive colleges increased by \$2.3 million, or 5.5 percent, and technology colleges gifts grew by \$0.8 million, or 7.8 percent compared to the prior year. Community colleges decreased \$3.7 million, or 8.1 percent, compared to the prior year. A comparison of gifts received by institutional grouping is shown below:

The five-year fundraising trend by institutional grouping is shown in the graph below. Gifts received in 2014-15 by doctoral degree granting institutions were \$28.1 million higher than the five-year average for that group. Gifts reported in 2014-15 increased \$4.4 million and \$2.0 million for comprehensive colleges and community colleges, respectively, while technology colleges remained relatively flat compared to their five-year averages.

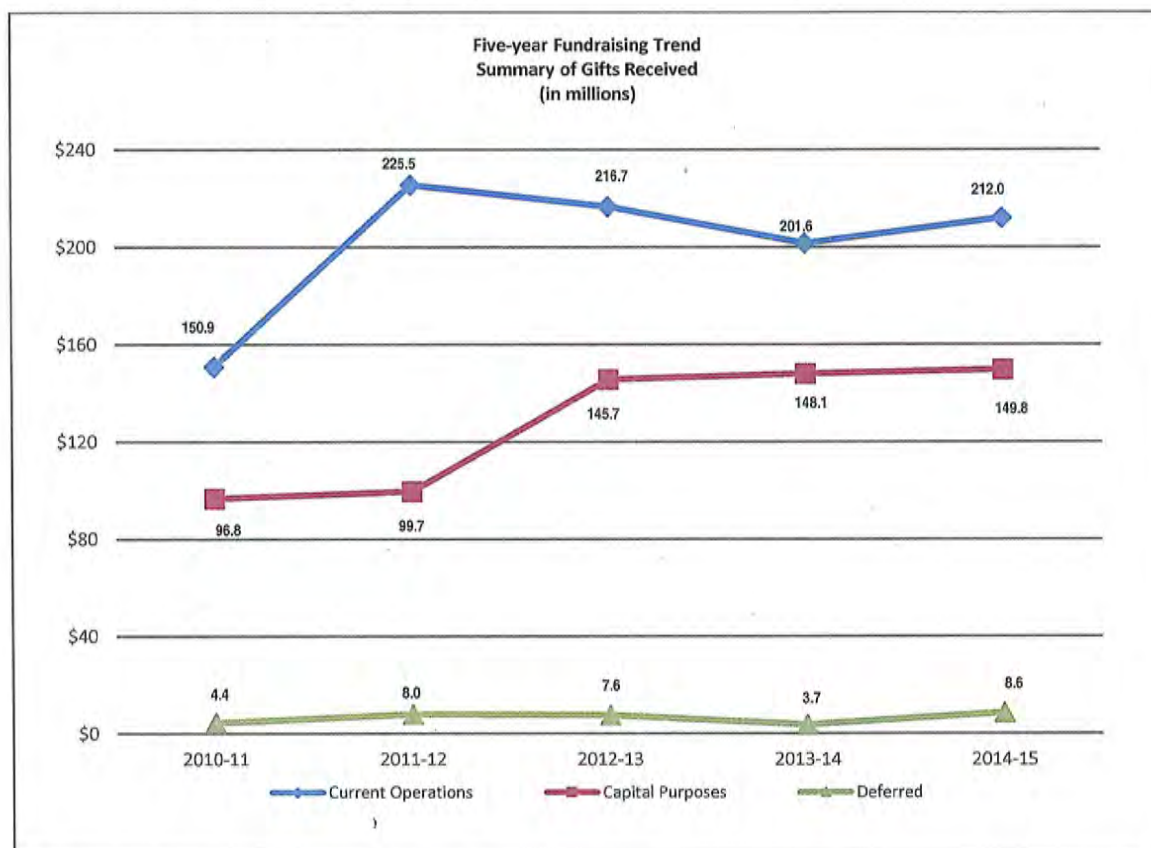

Outright gifts for current operations were \$212.0 million, outright gifts for capital purposes, including endowed gifts, totaled \$149.8 million, and deferred gifts were \$8.6 million. A summary of gifts compared to the previous fiscal year are shown below:

The five-year trend of gifts received by the State University is shown in the chart below. Outright gifts received in 2014-15 for current operations increased \$10.4 million, or 5.2 percent, compared to the prior year and were \$10.7 million higher when compared to the five-year average. Capital gifts increased \$1.7 million, or 1.2 percent, in 2014-15 compared to the prior year, and were \$21.8 million higher compared to the five-year average. Deferred gifts in 2014-15 increased \$4.9 million or 130.8 percent compared to the prior year and increased by \$2.1 million compared to the five-year average.

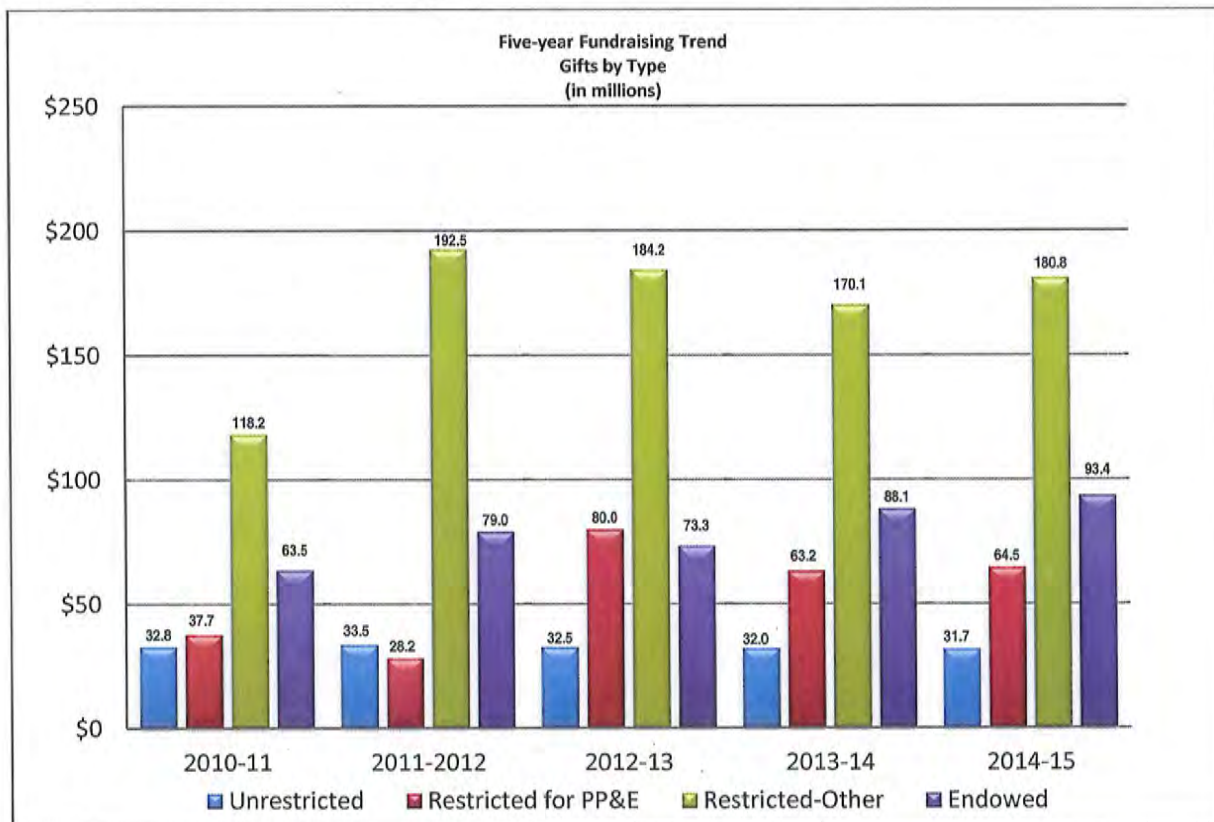

A summary of gifts by type compared to the previous fiscal year are shown in the table below. For 2014-15, 66.2 percent of the gifts received have restrictions on their use, 25.2 percent are endowed gifts – i.e., income producing gifts to be held in perpetuity, and approximately 8.6 percent are unrestricted. Compared to the previous fiscal year, restricted and endowed gifts increased, while unrestricted gifts decreased as shown below:

A summary of the five-year trend by gift type is shown in the graph below. Gifts restricted for other purposes, totaling \$180.8 million, were \$11.6 million higher than the five-year average. Endowed gifts and gifts restricted for PP&E were \$13.9 million and \$9.8 million higher than the five-year average, respectively. Unrestricted gifts decreased \$0.8 million compared to the five-year average.

- Gifts from affiliated foundations and organizations to the institution (because they are counted when received by the foundation or organization, not when they are passed to the institution itself)
- Investment earnings on gifts, even if accrued during the fundraising reporting year, and even if required under the terms specified by the donor (the only exception permitted being interest accumulations counted in guaranteed investment instruments that mature within the reporting year, such as zero-coupon bonds)
- Government funds, whether local, state (including state matching grants), federal, or foreign

Not included as voluntary support (cont.):

- Pledges (although the Financial Accounting Standards Board requires certain institutions to report unconditional pledges in their financial statements, these should not be included in annual gift totals of fundraising results)
- Revenue from special education programs
- Student financial aid when the gift is in support of a specific student identified by name
- Surplus income transfers from ticket-based operations, except for any amount equal to that permitted as a charitable deduction by the IRS
- Testamentary commitments (bequest intentions)
- Tuition payments
- Value of deferred giving contracts terminated due to the death of the income beneficiary during the year

Outright Gifts for Current Operations - Includes only outright gifts given specifically for current operations.

Unrestricted - Includes outright gifts, including realized bequests (estate settlements), given by donors without any restriction, regardless of any subsequent designation by the institution to be used for current operations, to function as endowment, to construct facilities, or for other purposes. In cases where the donor expresses a preference for the gift's use but leaves the decision to the institution, the gift is reported as unrestricted.

Restricted - Includes outright gifts for current operations that the donor has restricted for use in a particular purpose (i.e., scholarships, research, institutional support, athletics, etc.).

Outright Gifts for Capital Purposes - Includes only outright gifts for such purposes as property, buildings, equipment, endowment funds, and student loan funds.

Property, Buildings and Equipment - Includes outright gifts of both real and personal property for the use by the institution; gifts made for the purpose of purchasing buildings, other facilities, equipment, and land for use of the institution; gifts restricted for construction or major renovation of buildings and other facilities; and gifts made for retirement of indebtedness.

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Endowment Funds - Endowment funds are those that donors specify are to be retained and invested for income-producing purposes.

- **Endowment–Unrestricted** - Includes outright gifts restricted by the donor for endowment, but for which the donor has made no restriction regarding the use of the income produced by the endowment, regardless of any subsequent allocation the institution may make.
- **Endowment–Restricted** - Includes those outright gifts added to the endowment funds of the institution by donor direction, from which the income is limited by the donor for specific purposes or programs.

Loan Funds - Includes outright gifts restricted by donors to be available for loans to students, faculty, and staff.

Deferred Gifts - Includes only deferred gifts established or added to in the reporting period. Such gifts include charitable gift annuities, charitable remainder trusts (including those administered outside the institution), gifts to pooled income funds, and remainder interests in property. Deferred gifts are reported at present value.
